A) Рубрика

Kuskovo is first mentioned in documents dating from the beginning of the sixteenth century. It was a small boyar estate only about seven kilometers from Moscow. The land was not good for cultivation, and was thus of little economic significance. The estate was however an ideal hunting ground. In 1715 the Kuskovo estate was bought by Count Boris Sheremetev.

B) Рубрика
